BWA's Annual Symposium is held during the Congressional Black Caucus Foundation's Annual Legislative Conference and has become a flagship event. The Symposium, consisting of a morning Town Hall and afternoon Luncheon and highlights critical issues, recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions in key areas, and draws audiences of over 1,500 participants from across the country including Members of Congress, local and federal officials, business groups, educators, and others.

The Annual Symposium Town Hall is structured as a moderated panel conversation with experts discussing those areas critical to the African American family. Panelists provide practical solutions and strategies on how to address these issues.

The Annual Symposium Luncheon offers an opportunity to honor women who embody the spirit and action of our Ancestors uplifting black women and their families in the areas of education, health and economic empowerment. Since its inception in 1977, BWA has bestowed tributes of distinction upon phenomenal Black women. Luncheon honorees include luminaries such as Dr. Maya Angelou, Dr. Dorothy Height, Shirley Sherrod, Surgeon General Regina Benjamin, Alma Powell, Marian Wright Edelman, the Honorable Condoleezza Rice, the Honorable Kamala Harris, Sheila Johnson, Dr. Johnnetta B.
